Spring Conference Business Meeting

April 30, 2010 at The Lodge, Deadwood, SD

Minutes by Sheriff Howe

Meeting called to order by Sheriff Klinkhammer.

Dick Tieszen presented new legislative concerns from the 2010 legislative session.

An issue has come up regarding SDCL 24-11-8 requiring County Commissions to maintain a special building fund to retain out of county inmate boarding fees. Most counties are not in compliance with this law. Dick offered to approach the Auditor General to request that Counties be given consideration for lack of knowledge of the law and given time to comply or propose legislation.

Lanny appointed the Executive Board as well as Sheriffs Wishard, Rathbun, and Wellman to a legislative committee to monitor legislative concerns.

The Association was informed that the 911 Committee appointee needs to be re-appointed and the Association needs to present 10 names for the Governor to consider and he will choose the representative from the Sheriff's Association. There was discussion as to whether we need to present 10 names or can present the delegate of our own choosing. Staci will investigate that.

Sheriff Lamphere's term has expired on the Public Communication Committee. Sheriff Klinkhammer appointed Sheriff Ackerman to replace him.

The New Sheriff's School was discussed in preparation for incoming sheriffs after the fall elections.

The topic of the Sudafed log losing funding was discussed. Sheriff Mowell made a motion seconded by Sheriff Wellman to support Sheriff Milstead in a request for Byrne/Jag funding to the Sudafed log data entry. The motion also called for work toward a per capita assessment of counties and cities to cover any shortfall of funding to continue the data entry. The motion carried.

Sheriff Hillestad made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Sheriff Lamphere. Motion Carried
